Please do not come to Valetta St if you are sick.

If you have Covid-19 symptoms, please get tested and isolate as instructed by healthcare workers until you have a negative result.

When any member visits Valetta St, please observe the following, as necessary:

- Record your visit on the attendance record provided.
- Maintain physical distancing – 1.5 metres. No physical contact.
- Wait outside the building if necessary. Chairs will be provided.
- Wear a fitted mask that covers mouth and nose.
- Sanitise hands on entry and exit.
- Using wipes that are provided, sanitise:
 - the telephone handset.
 - surfaces including keyboard.
 - any chair and surface (eg table) that you use before and after use.
 - touch points such as door handles, switches, tap handles, toilet flush buttons.
- Stay for as short a time as possible.
- Bring your own water bottle.
- Use your own cup or a disposable one.
